

Code of Conduct Club Premises

The Code of Conduct provides members, guests, and visitors with guidance on the standards of behavior expected of them while on club premises and in their interactions with the Club. It has been developed to ensure everyone can enjoy the amenities provided by the club in a safe, enjoyable, and responsible manner.

Accordingly, members, guests, and visitors shall:

- Refrain from any behavior that may bring the Portarlinton Golf Club into disrepute.
- Respect the rights of others to enjoy the club's facilities and services.
- Interact with each other, the club's employees, and volunteers in a courteous manner.
- Not engage in behavior intended to abuse or harass each other, the club's employees, or volunteers.
- Refrain from disorderly or disruptive behaviors.
- Show due consideration to the needs of others, including their right to privacy.
- Comply with club policies, signage, and lawful directions of employees.
- Access the club with proper identification and fulfil any sign-in requirements.
- Ensure minors are accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Abide by the dress code of the club (available upon request).
- Not bring food or drinks for consumption on the clubhouse premises.
- Not bring alcoholic drinks for consumption on the premises.
- Not bring or possess illegal materials while on club premises.
- Handle property belonging to the club with care and diligence.
- Refrain from representing the club unless properly authorised.
- Not pursue personal activities on club premises without prior permission.
- Not deliberately tarnish the club's reputation or bring it into disrepute.
