

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the "Rules of Golf Effective January 2019" and any additional local rules as displayed on notice board at pro shop.

OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18):

- o All ground beyond boundary fences.
- o The area to the right hand side of the 10th hole defined by white pegs with black tops and white dots from the large buggy shed down to the water pipe on the boundary fence adjacent to the practice chipping green.

PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17):

- o Red Penalty Areas are defined by red stakes and/or lines.
- o Yellow Penalty Areas are defined by yellow stakes and/or lines.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16):

Full relief **MUST** be taken when the ball comes to rest in or near:

- o Clubhouse and work sheds (if ball lies within area bounded by blue stakes).

Full relief **MAY** be taken when the ball comes to rest in or near:

- o All stakes, hazard markers, pegs and ropes.
- o Hoses and sprinkler heads (if a sprinkler head interferes with the line of play AND the ball is not in a hazard AND is on or within two club lengths of the putting green AND is within two club lengths of the ball).

MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Wire hoops are movable obstructions.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16):

- o Wheel marks of a tractor, mower or motor vehicle in the “general area”.
- o All garden beds with white stakes and/or lines are compulsory GUR.
- o All other garden beds and mulched areas are “integral” parts of the course.

TREES AND SHRUBS (Rule 16.1b):

If a staked tree or shrub interferes with a player’s stance or intended swing, the ball MUST BE LIFTED and dropped.

LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS (Model Rule E-5):

The club encourages all players to hit provisional balls if in doubt as to location of previous stroke.

The 2019 Model Local Rule for Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Ball Out of Bounds is in effect.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Match play – Loss of hole.

Stroke play – Two strokes.
